DESERT WATER



1. How many gallons of water does the average Valley use in a year?

162,925 gallons (a half an acre foot). Roughly 150 gallons per person per day.

















2. How much of that water is used outdoors?

75% or about 120,000 gallons!















3. How much water (gal) have CVWaterCounts agencies saved since 2015?

Over 38,000,000,000 gallons!

















4. How many acre feet (325,851 gals) of water are stored in the aquifer system of the Coachella Valley?

In 1964, the DWR estimated that the Coachella Valley groundwater basin contained a total of approximately 39.2 million AF of water in the first 1,000 feet below the ground surface!















5. How many water/wastewater employees in the CV?

About 730.















6. About how many gallons of tap water can you buy for the price of a case of bottled water (\$3.00)?

About 1,500 gals.
