

Head to the kitchen and see if you can spot any drips.

HINT: Head to the sink...do you hear a dripping noise?

If you found a drop, check the Kitchen box below.

Now go to the bathroom...look around for pesky drips.

HINT: Look up at the shower faucet...and don't miss the sink.

Your parents can also help you with a leak test for toilets.

Put 2-3 drops of food coloring in the toilet tank and wait 10 minutes. If the toilet bowl has color, your toilet has a leak.

If you found a showerhead, faucet or toilet leak, check the Bathroom box below.

Next, ask your parents to turn on the sprinklers for just a few minutes.

Go out to the back yard. Are there any broken sprinklers or spots that water is being wasted?

HINT: Look for spots where water hits things besides plants...is there water on the pavement?

If you found water being wasted, check the Back Yard box below.

Head out to the front yard and check for the same.

Ask your parents what time of day they water - or what time of day the sprinklers go off. If the answer is NOT early in the morning or late in the evening, then you're wasting water.

Check the Front Yard box below if you found water waste.
