Changes are Coming

To help California become more drought-resilient, Assembly Bill 1572 (AB 1572) bans the use of potable water to irrigate non-functional turf (NFT) on commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, including HOAs, beginning January 1, 2029.

The goals of AB 1572 include:

- Reducing water waste
- Encouraging sustainable landscaping
- Strengthening local groundwater supplies
- Preparing for intensifying or increasing dry weather patterns

AB 1572 requires that water agencies adopt their own NFT ordinance and enforce the law, including issuing fines for non-compliance.
